- Full course fees must be paid at enrolment, the fees must be paid before a student can begin the course.
- The school reserves the right to cancel any courses that we deem undersubscribed, should this situation arise parents will be informed up to 7 days before the course starts. In this scenario a full refund will be organised for the student.
- Should a student wish to cancel after enrolment two weeks notice must be given, then a £25.00 administration charge will be made and the remainder refunded. If a cancellation occurs within 2 weeks no refunds can be given.
- We will do our utmost to accommodate every students needs and subject choices. We aim to cover core material, however students must be aware that we may not cover all exam board specifications.
- If there is an instance of poor behaviour by the student the matter will be addressed by either the houseparent for residential students, or the course tutor. Repeated poor behaviour will be dealt with by Management and the parents will be contacted, this could result the student being asked to leave the course.
- Under no circumstances should alcohol or drugs including the so called 'legal highs' be brought onto the premises, Monkton operates a no tolerance attitude in these circumstances the student will be asked to leave.
- No smoking or vaping is allowed on the premises, or in the school grounds.
- Residential students can arrive from 5pm on Sunday evening, day students should not arrive until 8.30am on Monday morning, or at 1.00pm if their chosen subject runs in an afternoon session. Lunch is provided for students taking two subjects, however this option is not available for those taking only one subject.
- Once on campus the students are required to stay on campus, written Parental consent must be obtained should the student need to leave the premises for any reason.
- Any damages to school property will be directly chargeable to the parents/guardians of the offended.
- Deliberate damage to another persons belongings will result in the student being taken off the course.
- Monkton is an inclusive school, we will not tolerate any racial behaviour.
